INSTALL Program

INSTALL is the only program you need to run before you use IDEAcomm 5251/Plus. It provides a fast, easy method for configuring IDEAcomm software for your PC or PS/2. (As an alternative, some users may want to customize IDEAcomm software further by running the IDEACFIG program described in the manual.)

- _____ ● Station address (0 to 6). Note that, if your card is connected to a host, **INSTALL** checks which station addresses are currently in use and will not accept these.

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- _____ ● Whether it will use a file transfer package (only applicable to the older 4 LU IDEAComm 5251 product).
 - _____ ● Your national language and keyboard layout (IBM 5250 or PC style — see the templates).
 - _____ ● PC printer type, if any (serial or parallel). The following printers are supported in Release 5.2. Consult the READ.ME file or run INSTALL for higher versions.

- _____ ● PC printer port, if any (LPT1, COM1, and so on).
- _____ ● What drive and pathname you will use to run emulation. You must create a sub-directory before running INSTALL. An example is: C:\TWINAX.

Running INSTALL

1. Install the IDEAComm card in the PC or PS/2 (Section II or III of the Hardware guide).
2. On a PS/2 Model 50 – 80, run the IBM configuration program on the Reference Diskette.
3. Connect the TWINAX cable (See the Hardware Guide).
4. Make a backup copy of the IDEAComm software and file the originals for safekeeping.
6. Insert the diskette labeled IDEACOMM-1. (At this point, you may copy all the IDEA diskettes to the hard disk, but INSTALL will do it for you more selectively.) Be sure that you are attached to the drive and path from which you want to run INSTALL.
7. At the DOS prompt type the following:

INSTALL <Enter>
8. The first screen of the INSTALL program is displayed. Read and follow the instructions for this and subsequent screens.

Error Messages

Cannot copy file

The IDEA file does not exist.

Cannot copy files to this directory

The pathname may not exist or the drive may not be accessible.

Could not determine memory and/or I/O addresses for the IDEComm 5251

Microchannel; Possible Actions:

- 1. Run diagnostics with the TWINDIAG program.**
- 2. Reconfigure the Personal System/2 with the Reference Disk.**

The configuration could not be determined from values read from the card. The ADF file may be invalid or damaged, or the card may be old or damaged. Call IDEA Technical Support.

Emulation Card is Defective

Call your local dealer.

Emulation Card is Not Installed

Check that the IDEComm card is properly seated in your PC and that it is properly seated. Refer to Section II or III of the Hardware Guide.

Emulation Card not installed in Personal System/2

The IDEComm MC card was not found.

IDEComm 5251/MC card failed diagnostics

Possible Action:

Run diagnostics with the TWINDIAG program.

See Appendix A for use of the TWINDIAG program.

Incorrect diskette in current drive

Insert the diskette that is requested at the bottom of the screen.

I/O Address DIP Switches are Not Set Correctly

Check the switch settings on your IDEComm card (Appendix C of the Hardware Guide — PC version only).

No space left in destination disk (diskette)

Remove some files currently on the disk, or insert a new diskette, and restart INSTALL.
