## Setting up your computer

### Connecting to a power source

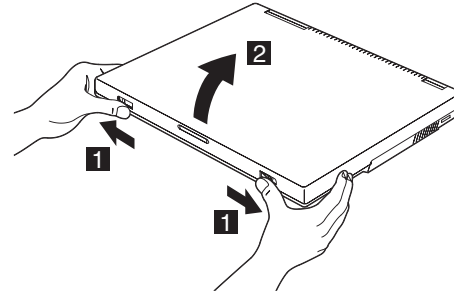
1. Insert the battery pack into the battery compartment located at the rear of the computer:
  1. Switch the battery lock **1** to the unlocked  position.
  2. Insert the battery pack into the battery compartment. **2**  
**Note:** Depending on the battery option you ordered, your battery may appear different from the figure.
  3. Switch the battery lock **1** to the locked  position.
2. Connect the ac adapter to the computer's power jack (at the rear of the computer) in the order shown.



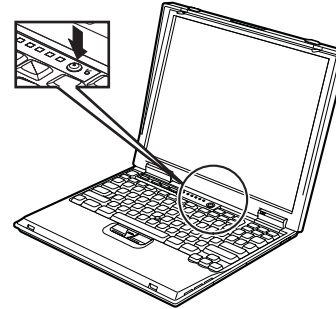
## Turning on the system

1. Open the computer display.

Slide the latches **1** and open the display **2**. Then position the display so that it is convenient for viewing.



2. Press the power switch.



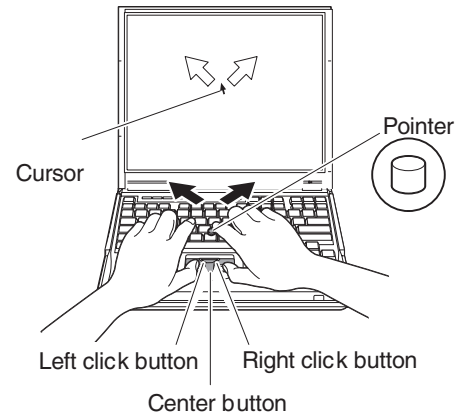
## Using the TrackPoint

The TrackPoint® is a unique device for moving the cursor on the screen. You can perform all mouse operations with the TrackPoint. The left and right click buttons function like the left and right click buttons of a mouse.

To move the cursor, use the red-tipped pointer at the center of the keyboard. Press gently with your left or right index finger in the direction you want to move the cursor. To select and drag an object, press and hold one of the click buttons with either thumb as required by your software.

**Click** means to press the left click button once. **Double-click** means to press the left click button twice within 1 second.

For more information about the TrackPoint, TrackPoint, press the ThinkPad button to open Access ThinkPad, your on-board help system.



## Using the volume control

You can adjust the sound level produced by the built-in speakers by using the following three buttons:

- Volume down



- Volume up:



- Mute:



- If the sound is muted when you turn off the computer, it remains muted when you turn the computer on again.
- To turn on the sound, press the Volume up or Volume down button.

When you press one of these buttons, the volume indicator appears on the screen for a few seconds. For more details on volume control, see the on-board help system, Access ThinkPad.

## Setting up Windows

Your computer comes with a Microsoft<sup>®</sup> Windows operating system. After turning on your computer, follow the instructions on the screen to set up the operating system. This procedure takes approximately 10 minutes, and your computer restarts several times.

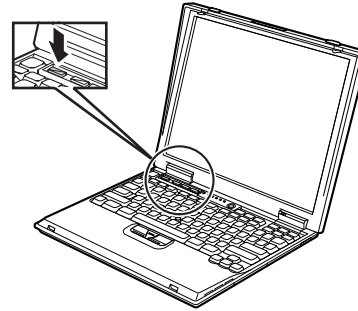
