Part 1. Using the IBM ThinkPad Ultrabay 2000 Battery

The *IBM ThinkPad Ultrabay 2000 Battery* (hereafter called the *second battery*) is supported for use with any ThinkPad computer that has an Ultrabay 2000 bay. By inserting the second battery, you can prolong the operating time.

To install the second battery into the Ultrabay 2000 bay of your ThinkPad computer, refer to the online information provided with your ThinkPad computer.
